SUBJECT: Allocations for Adult and Youth Programs for PY 2016

DATE: June 16, 2016

1. PURPOSE. To provide Locals with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult and Youth allocations for PY 2016 and additional information.

2. REFERENCES. Reference is made to WIN 15-12 that transmitted to you the WIOA percentage allocations for the Adult and Youth programs. Additional reference is made to TEGl 17-15.

3. BACKGROUND. The WIOA Adult allocations are for the program period July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2017, and the WIOA Youth allocations are for the program period April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

WIOA ALLOCATIONS FOR ADULT PROGRAMS The State allocation for Adults is **\$3,373,076**. The State Set-Aside for Adults is 15%, which equals **\$505,961**. The remaining 85% equaling **\$2,867,115** is distributed to the Local Areas according to the percentage allocation formula.

WIOA ALLOCATIONS FOR YOUTH PROGRAMS The State allocation for Youth is **\$3,880,689**. The State Set-Aside for Youth is 15%, which equals **\$582,103**. The remaining 85% equaling **\$3,298,586** is distributed to the Local Areas according to the percentage allocation formula.

Allotments are once again taken from two Federal budgets. Funds for the Adult program will be split into PY16/FY17. I will provide you with those amounts via a separate WIN.
